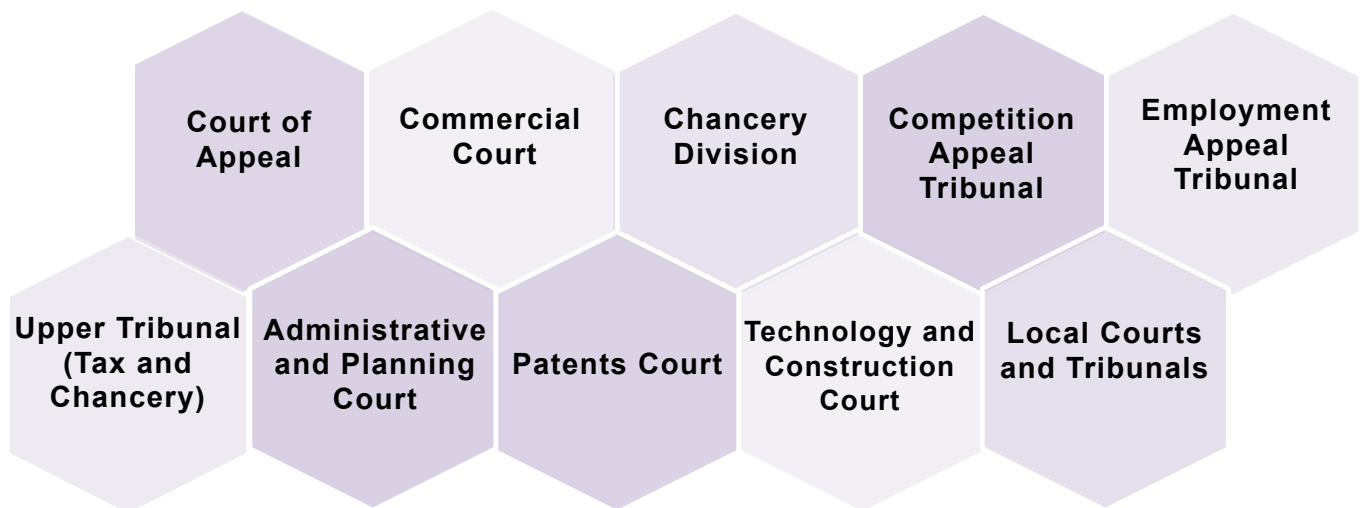




COURTS AND TRIBUNALS FELLOWSHIP SCHEME

The Industry and Parliament Trust’s Courts and Tribunals Fellowship scheme returned in autumn 2016. The scheme, operated in conjunction with the Judicial Office, is fully supported by the senior judiciary and will enable parliamentarians to undertake educational visits to a variety of courts and tribunals.

Participants will be offered a bespoke, five-day programme that will develop their knowledge and understanding of the judicial and legal systems. Typically, visits provide the opportunity to shadow courts and tribunals judges at all levels and attend a range of hearings across the jurisdictions.



WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Members of the House of Commons and House of Lords are welcome to take part in the scheme. Depending on the interests of the applicant, the IPT and Judicial Office will create a visit programme that is of greatest relevance to the parliamentarian.
